



Never use metal stakes, spikes, or fabric staples unless they are 24" (60cm.) or longer. Any unsafe items will be removed by the Trustees.



Do not take your neighbor's produce.



Trash cans are marked and are for trash only.

No plants, weeds or soil or to be placed in the trash cans.



Compost Pile Use of the composting pile promotes a good use of our natural resource, plus provides for the coming years' garden. The compost pile is for plant, soil and organic debris only. No trash is to be placed in the compost.



Never place rocks in the aisles or in other plots. Toss unwanted rocks in the stream.



No illegal plants, weapons, alcoholic beverages, or smoking allowed.



No ditching or damming allowed.



Do not extend plot lines outside the marked off area. All staking & fencing must stay inside the plot lines that were set on opening day.



Water will be turned off October 1.



By Oct. 30, 2022 you must remove all stakes, fencing, and other non-organic garden debris and place in the trash cans provided.

St. John Trustees will have regular walk-throughs to monitor the use of the Community Garden.
